Class Enrollment: Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations will be held at the Recreation office and will not be accepted during class. Classes not meeting their minimum enrollment will be cancelled.

**Registration Fees:** Program fees are listed throughout the program guide. All fees are due at the time of registration. Fees will not be prorated for missed classes.

Class Attendance and punctuality: Attendance is limited to individuals enrolled in the program. No make-up classes will be offered. It is essential to be on time. If a participant is late to class, they will need to check with the office to determine if they can join the course as long as the class is in the warm-up portion of the class. If a class has commenced the skill portion of the class, the participant will be asked to attend the next scheduled class.






